SCHOOL UNIVERSITY COUNSELING

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

In order to successfully complete Secondary School requirements and obtain a SABIS® High School Diploma, students must successfully complete 5 of the compulsory subjects, which include:


Mathematics, English, Arabic, Religion, and Jordan History, along with two subjects from the following optional courses: Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Economics, Business Studies, Psychology, Human Geography, Statistics. All students graduate with a globally recognized high school diploma.

SCHOOL CURRICULUM

The curriculum is derived from the SABIS® Educational System, which is a rigorous academic program with advanced-level courses that caters to both the American (AP®) and the British standardized examinations (GCE A-Levels & IGCSE), while preparing our students for the most prestigious universities in the world. However, due to the regulations of the Ministry of Education in Jordan, students can opt to sit for one kind of standardized exam.

Students are divided into two streams starting Grade 9:


