SLO Academic Department: MedWeek – A Journey Into the World of Medicine

The SLO Academic Department hosted a highly engaging and inspiring MedWeek, giving High School students a comprehensive look into the medical field through expert talks, practical workshops, and hands-on scientific exploration. The week brought together distinguished doctors, pharmacists, alumni, and representatives from the medical sector, all of whom shared invaluable knowledge and real-world insight.

Students began the week with a deep dive into surgery, guided by neurosurgeon Dr. Zaid Khalifeh, whose personal journey and professional experiences offered a powerful look into life in the operating room. ISC-Amman alumnus Dr. Shareef Halawa added an unforgettable practical element by leading a suturing workshop, teaching students the fundamentals of wound stitching and allowing them to practice techniques firsthand.

As the week continued, students heard from Dr. Nayef Abu Safieh (Class of 2017), who spoke candidly about the challenges and rewards of studying medicine as a SABIS® graduate. His reflections and advice provided students with a relatable and honest perspective on pursuing a medical career.













Midweek, the focus shifted to cardiology with Dr. Waleed Sawalha, who guided students through interactive stations featuring heart dissection and blood cell microscopy. These hands-on experiences brought scientific concepts to life and sparked curiosity in the field of heart health.

Students also explored the world of pharmacy through a session with Dr. Mazen Abu Samha, who discussed medication development, the role of pharmacists, and emerging breakthroughs in cancer treatment. The week concluded with representatives from The Kingdom Health introducing the vision for a new medical university in Amman, highlighting modern educational pathways for aspiring doctors.

MedWeek offered ISC-Amman students an enriching blend of theory, practice, and inspiration, opening their eyes to the many paths within the medical profession and motivating them to pursue their goals with confidence and passion.




Arab Children's Day: A Joyful Celebration of Culture and Identity


